Join in Playgroup

What is Join in Playgroup?

Autism SA invites parents and caregivers with children aged between 2-6 years of age to attend Join In playgroup and embrace the safe and welcoming environment that has been created to allow caregivers to practice developing their skills together.

Benefits of Join in Playgroup

Autism SA's Join In playgroup is an opportunity for parents and caregivers to Join in play with their child under guidance from a specialised early intervention therapist. Parents and caregivers will be provided opportunities within the program to build their skills in supporting their child to:

- Direct their own play
- Follow instructions
- Play with others
- Complete daily tasks such as getting dressed, brushing teeth, toileting, washing hands
- Engage in mealtimes.

Parents and caregivers will be provided tips and tricks to support their children to reach their potential. The leading therapist will support caregivers to utilise visual supports, positive behaviour support strategies and increase the caregiver's understanding of their child's sensory processing needs.

Take home resources are provided weekly and caregivers will be supported to implement strategies at home by planning home activities.

Length of the group

8 weeks of 2 hour sessions plus 30 minutes of non - contact support weekly

Cost

NDIS Funding can be used for the program. You may also elect to pay fee for service.
