



COVID-19 FACE MASKS

Decision-making for clients and visitors

Autism SA is defined as a 'public activity providing disability support services' under current State Directions.

The [current State Government law](#) means that *everyone* on our premises must wear a face mask when they are in the same room as another person. Our premises include our Tonsley and Elizabeth offices and FSG sites, as well as all residential homes, community places and other spaces we use to deliver services to clients.

There are some exceptions. Our clients with a disability do not need to wear a face mask, but they can if they want to. You can use this decision-making flowchart to help you decide if you should be wearing a face mask.
