What has been thought of when making the policy?



- Safe environments for clients, families, and employees
- Medical emergencies
- Behavioural challenges
- Personal care e.g., toileting
- Wellbeing of clients
- Feedback to parents
- Work, health, and safety protocols
- Duty of care



What does this mean at Autism SA locations?

- Parents or persons responsible must always be on site.
- If waiting in your car, you have to let staff
 know and be in the waiting room to get your
 child at the end.



What does this mean in the client's home?

- Parents or persons responsible must always be at home.
- If the parent or persons responsible leave the home, the session will finish immediately.





- The employee will consider what has happened.
- The employee will cancel the session if it is not safe to continue.



The parent or persons responsible must tell
the employee where they are going, when
they are coming back, contact details and
what will happen if they have not come
back by the agreed time.
