About this research opportunity

Worldwide organisations are reforming their recruitment and employment practices to attract, employ and benefit from neurodivergent talent, including large global corporations and government departments. Organisations that focus on being more neuro-inclusive are expanding their talent pool and are benefiting from greater neurodiversity in the workplace. This can be achieved by addressing barriers in the recruitment and employment process that may disadvantage neurodivergent job seekers and employees.

To support employers in overcoming these barriers and foster inclusive organisational and employment outcomes, Autism SA has developed the Neuro-inclusive Recruiting online resources available at neuroinclusiverecruiting.org.au.
